

## Decentering

Step 1: Back Translation

Decentering is an iterative process whereby the researcher performs back translation, modifies the ORIGINAL text if unsatisfied, performs back translation on the modified original text, and continuing until satisfied. The key is to draw a balance between translational accuracy and maintaining the original text.




**Step 2: Modify Original Text**
