

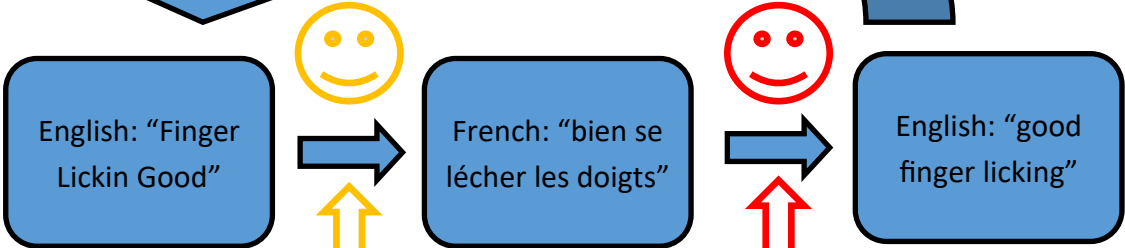
Parallel Translation

French translated BACK to English

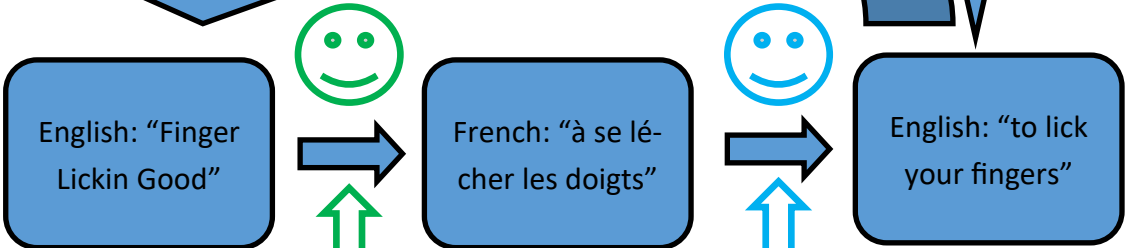
English results are compared and the best French translation chosen.
